Facility Conditions

- Building not fully fire sprinklered
- Non-ADA compliant restrooms
- Acoustical control issues in commons
- Poor organization and way finding in administration
- Small concession stand for events
- FCS classrooms are dated
- Wrestling room is to small
- Fitness center not big enough for community & school use
- HS does not have an art room
- Roof replacement over 2001 portions of building

Facility Deficiencies



- Mechanical equipment replacements
- Science labs are dated
 - Do not function for current trends in education
- School is maxed out on student lockers
- CTE space is not sufficient for current trends
- HS has isolated academic classrooms
- Athletic Locker rooms have accessibility issues
- Athletic Locker rooms in main gym are not large enough
- Athletic locker rooms lack individual showers
- Facility does not offer a secure entry
- Dated finishes in commons

Facility Deficiencies



- Drop off and pick for both busses and parents
- Gate admission & amenities for baseball / softball
- Gate admission & amenities for football / track
- Football & Track lighting
- Football & Track visitor bleachers
- Add parking where possible
